INSTRUCTIONS

Students MAY ALSO purchase/borrow an Audible or other audio edition of the text. However, a printed copy is still required for class.

Bring the Summer Reading book to class on the first day of school.

What if I am in Dual Credit/Enrollment English?

Summer Reading is attached your English class.

Students who are ONLY enrolled in a DC/DE college English class are exempt from the summer reading requirement.

However, if a student is *also* taking ELA 11 (American Lit) or ELA 12 (British Lit) in addition to their DC/DE class, they would still be required to complete summer reading.
